- National Single Window (Trade single window; we are in process of developing a national trade single window to streamline all trade procedures) as well as simplification and digitalizing trade procedures, on this matter, we look forward to your recommendation of organizing study visits to leading countries/best practice examples, and what are the challenges and opportunities in this regard.
- Palestine is not a member at the WTO, we want to know more about WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement (TFA) implementation and other countries experiences in this regard.
- In regard to regional cooperation such as the Regional Single Window, it is quite interesting, but and we are interested to have a concept paper about such a Regional Single Window to be shared with all relevant countries (a South-South or North-South window), the issues, challenges, opportunities, and the feasibility of such a Regional SW.
